Application

Put Lighting Wool in the stove. To prepare the fire, take small, dry wood or charcoal. Light the fire. Lighting wool burns for a long time and ignites gradually, itself and the wood or charcoal. Keep out of reach of children. Do not inhale fumes. Do not use in embers or open flame. When using a barbecue, wait until the lighting wool has burnt completely before placing the food on the barbecue.

Shelf life and storage

Shelf life 10 years at +20°C in unopened original packaging and at normal humidity. Store the product in a dry place and below +45°C.
